Begonia Care:

Begonias are usually found with origins from Brazil and Vietnam and all places in between the most common are rex and angel wing type.

Their foliage is fleshly and crisp and easily snapped off with your finger.

They have such unique and beautiful foliage, which sparkles in the light for most types.

Easily perplexing because they don't like dry air and yet seem to hate wet soil...

Light: Bright indirect light. These plants tend to burn in full sun but are not a low light plant.

Air: humid and not dry

Soil: Well draining. the soil should not be too deep (soil to root ratio). The tubers do not like to be too far in the soil. Espoma cactus and citrus soil is a good mix to use.

Water: only when dry and thoroughly saturate like a succulent

Humidity: Keep in humid environment or next to a grouping of plants. Do not mist but humidity trays will work.
